#### Program Contents

Level	Topic And Function of Korean Classes	Extra Activities
Beginner	Can understand and express greetings, everyday life, daily activities, holidays, plans, health, hobbies, things you like, travel, and etc. Can communicate on a basic level for buying things, shopping clothes, ordering food, asking directions, celebrating and comforting	Speech
Intermediate	Speaking about and learning expressions on familiar social topics such as school life, job and workplace, personality, dating, and performances	Presentation
Advanced	Learning Korean expressions on the student's various interests on politics, economics, society, and culture	Presentation

**Class Method**

- Real-time online classes through ZOOM
- Placement Test: 1:1 Speaking Interview through ZOOM after the application deadline

**Completion Standards:** A completion certificate will be issued when the student's attendance rate and grade is over 70% (PDF)

**2. Application Procedure**

**Application**

- **Application Method: Submit the application documents via email([korean@korea.ac.kr](mailto:korean@korea.ac.kr))**

**[Application Documents] 1) a completed application form 2) a copy of passport**

- Application Procedure: Submit application form by email → Acceptance and Payment Notice → Confirmation of payment and finalization of enrollment → Placement test(after the application deadline)
- ※ The class may not open if the minimum number of applicants is not met.

**Tuition fee**

- Total fees: 1,000,000 KRW (Admission Fee 60,000 KRW / Tuition Fee 940,000 KRW)
  - The admission fee is non-refundable.
  - Students should bear all the burden of the fee, during transferring the tuition fee.
- Fee Reduction Policy
  - The fee reduction can be applied when verifying materials are submitted.
  - If a student is eligible for more than one discount, the higher discount will apply.
  - Fee Reduction Types
    - 1) Immediate family members who sign up for the same term: 10% reduction of the tuition fee for each student
    - 2) Children of Korea University employees and alumni: 10% reduction of the tuition fee
    - 3) Students currently attending Korea University: 20% reduction of the tuition fee
    - 4) Foreign diplomats and government officials residing in Korea and their family members dispatched to Korea by their country's government: 20% reduction of the tuition fee
