- Admission fee is non-refundable.

- Fee Reduction Policy
- The fee reduction can be applied when verifying materials are submitted.
- If a student is eligible for more than one discount, the higher discount will be applied.
- Fee Reduction Types
 - 1) 20 % reduction for students currently attending Korea University
 - 2) 20% reduction for foreign diplomats and government officials residing in Korea and their familiy
 - 3) 10% reduction for immediate family members who sign up for the same term
 - 4) 10% reduction for children of Korea University employees and alumni
